Drivers must have a valid drivers' license to operate the golf cart and it must always on their person during operation.	
Operator will obey all posted speed limits and must remain under 20 mph on any street, alley or road.	
Golf carts must be equipped with Headlights, Taillights, brake lights and turn signals that are in working order	
A current registration sticker must for affixed on the rear of the vehicle.	
Proof of liability insurance must always in the vehicle or on the operator during the operation of the golf cart.	
Operators are responsible for knowing and following all applicable laws, statutes, and ordinances.	
Operators are not to carry more passengers than recommended by the manufacturer. All passengers must be seated at all times.	
Golf carts are not permitted on walking trails without written approval by the Park Department.	
No use of electronic/cellular devices while driving.	
Golf carts may be operated on State Road 10 (also known as Walnut St) and on old US Highway 31 (also known as Michigan St.), but golf carts shall be driven and operated on the far-right hand side of the roadway and shall not impede the normal flow of traffic.	
Applications/Registrations are due by June of each year.	
All golf carts must be maintained in a safe and operational condition.
