The Town of Argos Town Council met on April 22, 2026 @ 7:00pm in the council room at 201 W. Walnut St. for a Regular Town Council Meeting. Those present were President Ed Barcus, Members Erica Partin, Charles Snead, Robert Byers, Clerk-Treasurer Lisa Mullaney, and Attorney Derek Jones. Vice President Shawn Harley was absent.

UPDATE ON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FROM MACOG
